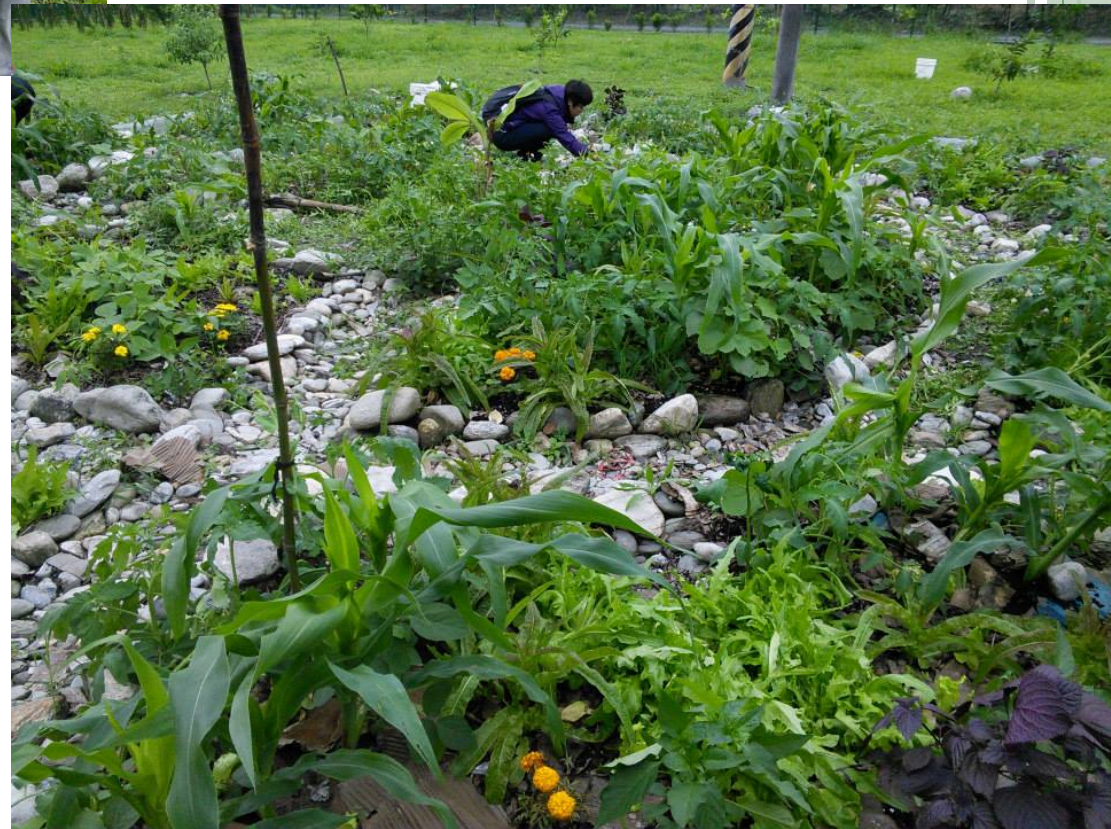


PERMACULTURE ORIGINS

- Permaculture is the union of many different disciplines and ways of knowing, put together in order to foster holistic understanding and ACTION















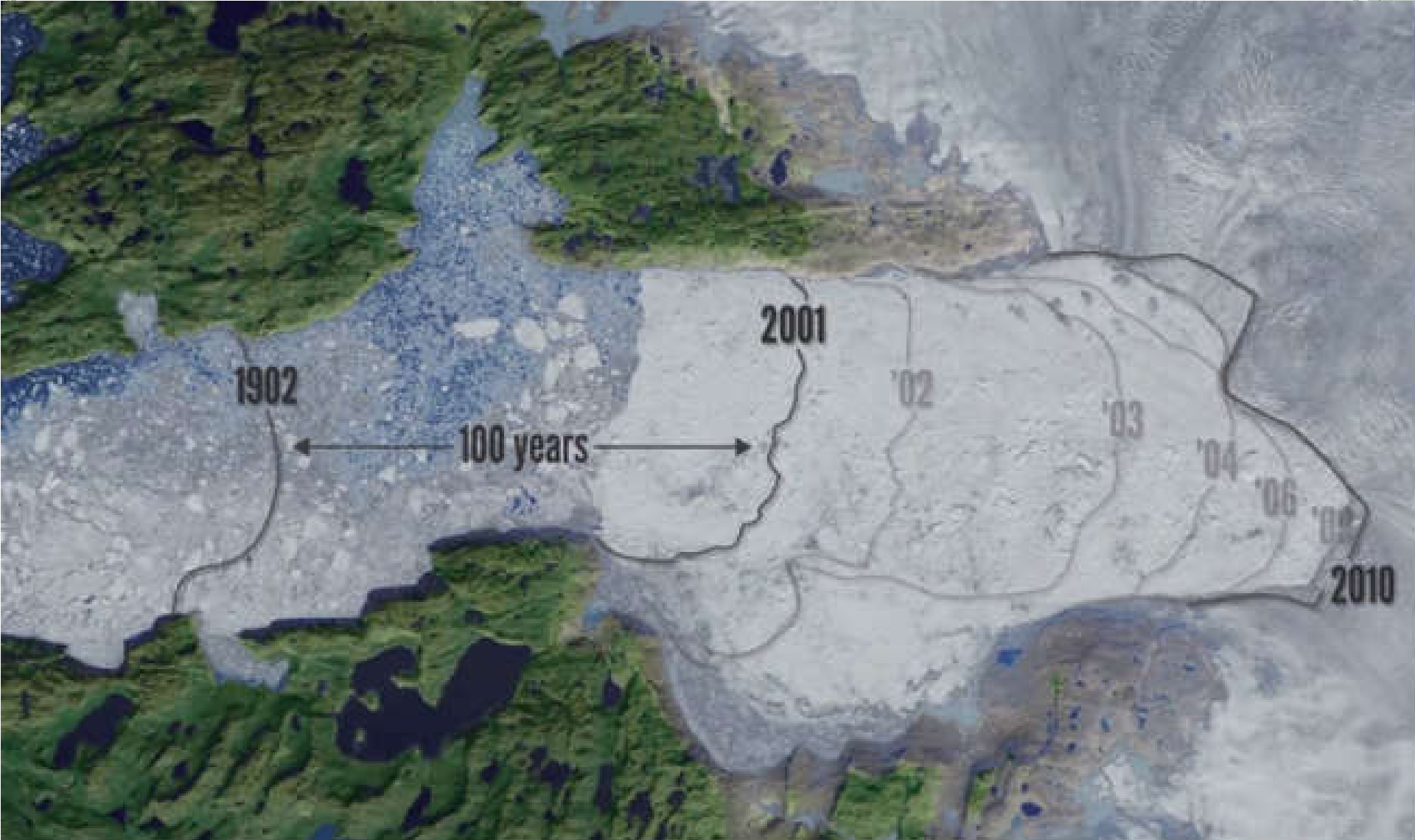
Permaculture: External Yoga

Yoga: Internal Permaculter









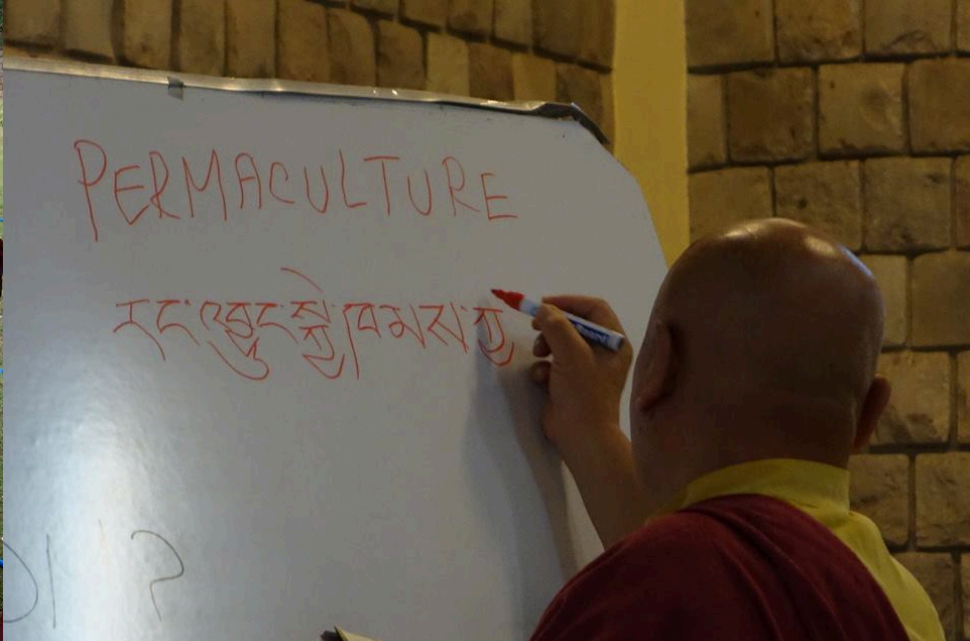
